Mike Nicholson has had many educational experiences including classroom teacher, administrator, and other leadership roles. He is the Director of Research Evaluation for Battelle for Kids. This seminar will provide an overview of the underlying principles and rationale for Value-Added Analysis and show how value-added information can be used to benefit schools.

#### **October 23, 2007 - How Your School Measures Up** *Presented by Steve Rogaski (4:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.)*

Steve Rogaski serves as Director of Pupil Services for the Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County. He will demonstrate a new data tool, Measure Up, and show how this instrument can assist school leaders in explaining and analyzing their report card data.

#### **November 15, 2007 - Tips and Tools for Differentiated Instruction** *Presented by Margaret Searle (4:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.)*

Margaret Searle is President of a consulting firm based in Perrysburg, Ohio. She is a national consultant in many educational areas including differentiated teaching techniques. Questions that she will address during this seminar include: How does any teacher meet the needs of a class with such different styles and levels of learning? What does differentiation look and sound like? What are three strategies that can be put in place to help teachers know how to intervene with students who "fall through the cracks?"

#### **February 9, 2008 - Sharing Effective Practices: Differentiated Instruction** *Facilitated by Robin Mis, Phi Delta Kappa Region Ei Liaison (9:30 a.m.- 1:00 p.m.)*
